

<p>All electrical permit applications must be accompanied by a detailed equipment list including a count of outlets, switches, and specifying all equipment to be installed. Copy of Prince Georges County Electrical and Contractors/Master License must be submitted with application</p> <p><b>***BASE FEE ADDED TO ALL PERMITS (unless otherwise noted)***</b></p>

<i>Multi-Family Dwelling- (Includes service and interior wiring)</i>	\$100- Per Unit

<i>Telephone, Alarm System, Central Vacuum, Intercom and similar low voltage systems (entire dwelling unit)</i>	\$55
<i>HVAC system replacement including (1) condensing unit and/or (1) air handling unit (furnace)</i>	\$55

<i>Theaters, Arts Centers- Including- Motion picture booths (with equipment), Stage lighting (including controls), Public address system (with speakers)</i>	\$150

<b>Antennae, Satellite Station, (Radio, TV, Communications)</b>	<b>\$100</b>

<b>Investigation (work performed without proper license and/or work performed without a permit)</b>	
➤ Residential	\$100

<b>Permit Revision (change owner name, address, or additional work to be included)</b>	<b>\$50 Administrative fee + additional cost of any new work</b>
<b>Plan Review (\$90 payable when plans submitted)</b>	<b>\$90 per hour/1hr min</b>
➤ Residential addition or commercial tenant fit-up under 5000 square feet	
➤ New commercial construction over 5,000 square feet	<b>\$90 per hour/2hr min</b>
<b>Re-inspection Fee (after 2<sup>nd</sup> failed inspection)</b>	
➤ Residential	\$100
➤ Commercial	\$150
<b>Special Conditions (service and/or conditions not provided for in this schedule)</b>	<b>\$90 per hour/1 hr min</b>
<b>Reconnection of existing electric service</b>	<b>\$50</b>
<b>Renewal of expired "BGE" Cut-in Certificate (CIC)</b>	<b>\$50</b>
<b>Homeowner electrical exam (exam fee only)</b>	<b>\$100</b>
